TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS:

The County of Orange, in compliance with the Citizen Participation Plan for the Urban County of Orange will amend the FY 2019-20 Annual Action Plan by reallocating the City of Stanton's Public Facilities & Improvement (PF&I) Project (Redirection of project funds to Homeless Shelter in Orange County) in the amount of \$100,000 to Housing Rehabilitation Program. Increase City of Yorba Linda's PF&I Improvement Project (ADA Improvements – Public Facility) by \$60,000 with PF&I reprogrammed funds from FY 2018-19 Capital Improvements to Homeless Shelter(s). The purpose of this notice is to provide the public a 30-day review period, beginning December 6, 2019 and ending January 7, 2020, to express their concerns and comments regarding the amended projects. The County of Orange is then required to submit the FY 2019-20 Substantial Amendment to HUD for approval.
